CITY OF JOHNS CREEK BOOT CAMP

The City of Johns Creek Recreation & Parks Boot Camp program directed by X5 Sports is geared to help you get into great shape, reduce stress, lose weight, increase energy, builds confidence and new boot camp friendships. Boot Camp is for men and women of all ages, sizes, shapes and fitness abilities. Everyone is encouraged to do their best. All camps will be directed by professional X5 Sports boot camp fitness instructors. (This is an ongoing camp broken down into 4 week sessions)

Location: Newtown Park

Session: Each session last 4 weeks beginning on a Monday and ending on the Friday of the 4th week.

CITY OF JOHNS CREEK SUMMER BASEBALL CAMPS

The City of Johns Creek's Summer Baseball Camps will be directed by the professional baseball staff from the Grand Slam Sports Center. All campers will have the opportunity to enhance their baseball skills through proven drills and fun games.

Location: Ocee Park

Time: 9:30am – 1:00pm

Ages: 7-13 years of age *Campers will be grouped by age

Camp Ratio: There will be a camper to instructor ratio of 10:1

Camp Size: Each camp is limited to the first 50 campers

Camp Fee: \$150 per child per session

Dates: Camp #1: June 14 – June 17, Camp #2: June 28 – July 1, Camp #3: July 19 – July 22



CITY OF JOHNS CREEK (GRPA) STATE SWIM TEAM

Do you love to swim? Come be a part of an unforgettable experience, the City of Johns Creek/GRPA State Swim Team! This "all-star" swim team is a great opportunity to compete at the state level at the Georgia Recreation & Parks Association (GRPA) State Swim Meet, make new friends from other neighborhood teams and associations, and most importantly... to have FUN. The qualifiers will be held at the ASA League Championship Meet where the top 3 designated finishers in each individual event will qualify for the Johns Creek Swim Team. In addition, up to 12 of the top freestyle finishers in each age group will qualify to swim freestyle relays for Johns Creek Swim Team.

Qualifiers: You must participate in the ASA League Championship Meet, June 25 & 26 to qualify for the JCST.

GRPA State Meet: Hosted by Carrollton, GA Recreation & Parks, July 30 & 31

Registration: Swimmers who qualify will be required to commit and register for the J.C.S.T on the day of the qualifying meet. Birth Certificates are due at qualifiers if not received before hand.

Age: 7 years of age and older

Cost: \$55 per swimmer

Registration: August 9 – 20

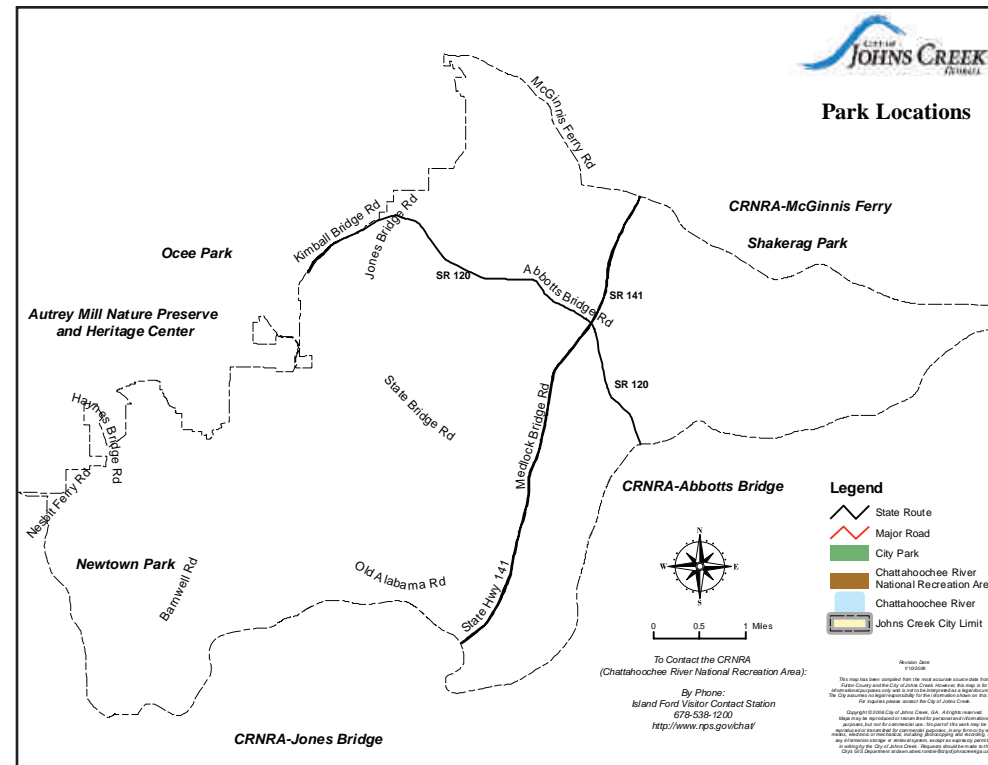
Game Times: 6pm, 7pm, 8pm, 9pm

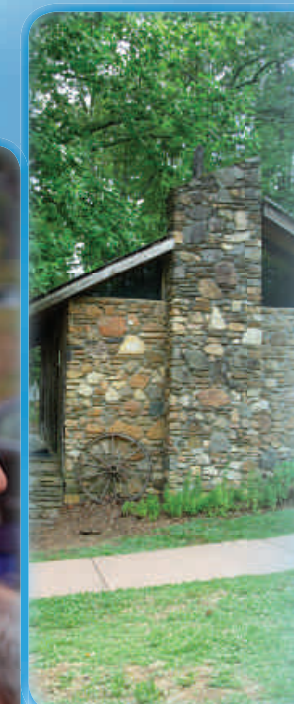

Autrey Mill Nature Preserve and Heritage Center

Autrey Mill Nature Preserve and Heritage Center is located at 9770 Autrey Mill Road across from Country Club of the South. It has 46 acres of ravine forest, with two-plus miles of walking trails which wind past a scenic creek with rocky shoals, picturesque cliffs, mature trees, wildflowers, native plants and animal life. Facilities include a Heritage Village consisting of several historic houses, replica Native American dwellings, and a Visitor's Center that houses several live animal displays.

Newtown Park

Newtown Park is located at 3150 Old Alabama Road, directly across the street from Johns Creek Fire Station #3. Facilities include 3 softball/baseball fields, 3 multi-purpose athletic fields, 6 tennis courts, 2 outdoor basketball courts, a 2-mile multi-use path, 13 picnic pavilions, a dog park, 2 playgrounds and a small lake.

Ocee Park

Ocee Park is located at 10900 Buice Road at the corner of Kimball Bridge Road. Facilities include 8 softball/baseball fields (lighted), 4 picnic pavilions, playground, 2 sand volleyball courts, 2 outdoor basketball courts and walking/jogging track.

Shakerag Park

Shakerag Park is located adjacent to River Trail Middle School at 10945 Rogers Circle. Facilities include a 3.8 acre lake, playground, 3 picnic shelters and a large multi-purpose athletic field surrounded by a jogging track.

Age: Boys and Girls ages 7-14

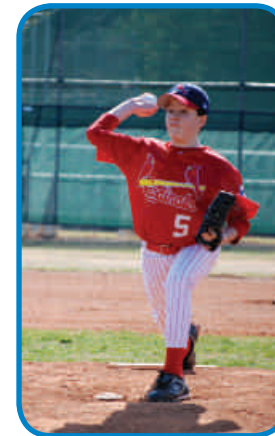
