Green Plan

- Good idea - would love walking trails from Johns Creek Walk going north. We need to save the trees and natural areas and cut level and traffic! I would like to see some financial help for senior citizens like Alpharetta has in the Ocee area. Classes there are too expensive. Many seniors are single on fixed incomes earned \$25,000 yr.
- Please be careful using wetlands behind homes for parks.
- Dr. Drummond did a nice job explaining various issues.
- The trail for priority on Buice Road should not be made if people want to get to pavilion on Autrey Mill they can take Jones Bridge.
- We need to make our roads part of our Green Plan by enforcing sign ordinances, forcing developers to clean up when done, placing meaning for \$\$ in escrow before a project starts and if it fails to meet the completion date, the city can use the escrow \$\$ to plant trees and bushes. Make all guard rails out of timbers not steel. Bury power lines as often as possible. Stop Suwannee Power from spraying "agent orange" under their power lines and creating ugly dead bush.
- I like the idea of expanding Autrey Mill. The basic concept for the Greenway from Buice, through Autrey Mill & connecting to Old Alabama is good. However the correction needed on the location has not been made. As shown, it goes down the middle of the second "(new)" reservoir at the water Treatment Plant. Additionally, the city received a position letter from Autrey Mill listing a number of security concerns in May 2007. We would like an answer. Please make sure final documents show the second reservoir at the Water Treatment Plant Also, please be sure Autrey Mill is shown completely on all maps and spelled correctly in all documents.
- Park development effort did not address existing Warsaw and Macedonia cemeteries as green areas but non-park items to ensure not only protection but security access controls (i.e. parks not accessing cemeteries - a must!)
- Keep watch on the Findley horse farm property for a potential park! It couldn't be a better location next to the elementary and adjacent/close proximity to several subdivisions. Can we make a bid for the abandoned roadway along McGinnis attached Cambridge? Would love to see this as "green space" undeveloped but maintained.
- Protection of cemeteries and development around
