# City of Johns Creek Parks

## **Autrey Mill Nature Preserve & Heritage Center (9770 Autrey Mill Road)**

Forty-six acres of natural ravine forest, with over 2 miles of walking trails winding past a scenic creek with rocky shoals, picturesque cliffs, mature trees, wildflowers, native plants and animal life.

Facilities include a Heritage Village with several historical buildings, replica Native American dwellings, and a Visitors Center that houses live animal displays. Autrey Mill is a popular location for scouting activities and Eagle Scout projects.

## **Newtown Park (3150 Old Alabama Road)**

Fifty-two acre park with three softball/baseball fields, 3 multi-purpose athletic fields, 6 tennis courts, 2 outdoor basketball courts, a 2-mile multi-use path, 13 picnic pavilions, Dream Dog Park, 10,600 square-foot Newtown Park Amphitheater, Veterans Memorial Walk, community garden, 2 playgrounds and a small lake. Park Place at Newtown School (the City's premier active adult center) and the Newtown Community Clubhouse are located in the park.

## **Ocee Park (10900 Buice Road)**

Thirty-seven acre park with eight lighted softball/baseball fields, 4 picnic pavilions, 2 playgrounds, 2 tennis courts, 2 sand volleyball courts, 2 outdoor basketball courts and a half-mile walking/jogging track.

## **Shakerag Park (10945 Rogers Circle)**

Sixty-six acre park with a lake (3.8 acres), playground, 3 picnic shelters, quarter-mile jogging track, 3 large multi-purpose athletic fields and 2 miles of nature trails.

# Park Facility Highlights

## Newtown Dream Dog Park

The Newtown Dream Dog Park has 2-acres of artificial turf, sprinklers for dogs to play in, obstacles to play on, plus water fountains for pets. It's a popular destination for dog lovers across Metro Atlanta and considered one of the top dog parks in the country.



## Newtown Community Garden

The 41-plot Community Garden is located inside Newtown Park and contains 35, 4'x8' raised beds, 4 tall planting tables and 2 beds that are handicap accessible. The garden is managed by the Johns Creek Garden Association.



## Newtown Park Amphitheater

The Newtown Park Amphitheater provides a delightful venue for City-sponsored special events and summer concerts. Designed with stacked stone and arches of Southern pine, the 10,600 square-foot open-air amphitheater offers up to 400 seats under cover, and another 1,000 seats on its terraced grass surroundings.



## Johns Creek Veterans Memorial Walk

The Johns Creek Veterans Memorial Walk, inside Newtown Park, serves as a place for visitors to reflect on the sacrifice of those who served in the military and as a location for patriotic events in Johns Creek.

The Memorial Walk features 10 plazas commemorating conflicts dating to World War I, plus Women in Service, Purple Heart recipients, and POW-MIAs. Each plaza features an 1,800-pound monument with etched photographs and colored service ribbons specific to each conflict.

Granite benches at each memorial plaza and the gazebo in the center of the Memorial Walk provide ample space for rest and reflection.

## Clubhouse Fitness Classes

## Johns Creek Park Geocaches

The Johns Creek Recreation & Parks Division has hidden geocaches throughout our City recreation areas to encourage people to explore our parks' scenic trails and natural spaces. In a high-tech treasure hunt, visitors armed with GPS units experience unique pathways, historic places, or beautiful views as they try to locate geocaches, which could be in a tree, behind a rock, or under a log.

To start, participants should visit [www.geocaching.com](http://www.geocaching.com) to create a profile and find coordinates at one of our parks. Coordinates need to be transferred into a portable GPS unit, which is used to guide the geocache hunter to the precise hiding spot. Traditional caches may contain maps, key chains, fishing tackle, rain ponchos, stickers and many other trinkets.

Once you find a geocache, the basic rules are to take something, leave something, and log your achievement in a notebook and/or online. To learn more, please visit [geocaching.com](http://geocaching.com).

# Park / Facility Improvements

## Recently completed projects:

### Autrey Mill Nature Preserve

- Completed outdoor lighting project along parking areas as well as the historical village
- Completed a large scale drainage project that pulled water away from the park's historic structures

### Newtown Park

- Construction of the Newtown Park Amphitheater
- Construction of the Johns Creek Veterans Memorial Walk
- Renovation of the Clubhouse to include 24 hour ADA accessible restrooms on the walking trail, and the addition of a 600 square-foot deck.
- Construction of a new access road in front of Park Place with the installation of 13 new parking spots
- Repaved the parking lot at the Clubhouse
- Installation of lights at the Dream Dog Park
- Installation of new batting cages

### Ocee Park

- New, large pavilion constructed between Fields One and Two
- A new pavilion constructed in the upper parking lot
- A new sidewalk installed for easier access to the back playing fields
- Completed the Buice Road landscaping project at the park entrance

### Shakerag Park

- Installed a 1.2 mile nature trail on the park's lower end

### State Bridge Park

- Began the development of this three acre "pocket" park. Tentative opening date will be the Fall of 2015

## Registration / Refund Policy

- Registration can be completed online (for most programs) or in-person at Park Place (senior center) located inside Newtown Park.
- Return checks are subject to a \$35 fee.
- Refund requests must be in writing and are subject to approval by Recreation & Parks staff.
- A \$20 processing fee will apply to most refunds.
- When applicable, no refunds for programs will be issued after the first class.
- Refunds are issued either by check or by reversing credit card charges (but may take up to 30 days for processing). There are no cash refunds.

## Cancellation Policy

- Any classes/programs not meeting minimum enrollment requirements may be postponed or cancelled.
- If your class/program is cancelled, you will be notified. Classes also may be cancelled due to inclement weather or instructor scheduling issues.
- A full refund will be given for cancelled classes/programs.

## Non-Resident Fee Policy

Non-residents will pay an increased fee of 50% for all City of Johns Creek programs and facility rentals. Non-resident fees are collected from participants that participate in Johns Creek programs that do not live within the City limits. These fees are being collected to help with park maintenance which is not being funded by non-residents who do not pay City of Johns Creek taxes.


