



Re: Converting CAD files to GIS

The City of Johns Creek has a GIS network of property information and the intent of this document is to request new land development or public works projects to share their property information to improve the accuracy of the City's GIS network. The City has chosen to utilize *.dxf files as the format to translate information. This will allow both AutoCAD and Microstation V8 users to translate into the same file format. Following the steps below will ensure the information provided will accurately overlay with the City GIS network.

1. Download the City of Johns Creek DXF seed file from the City's Right-of-Way web page:

2. Open the DXF file and you will find a shape which identifies the City Limits.
3. Now you can reference your project information to be shared and ensure the linework fits within the City Limits.
4. Be sure to only include the following information in the file submitted to the City.
(See Example)
 - a. Existing Property Lines
 - b. Proposed Right of Way Lines
 - c. Proposed Permanent Easement Lines
