Johns Creek Mayor **Mike Bodker** was elected the first mayor of Johns Creek, Ga., on Nov. 7, 2006.

Since his election, Mayor Bodker has spearheaded the formation of the North Fulton Municipal Association and served as its inaugural chairman. He also served as the chairman of the Metro Atlanta Mayors Association, as well as on the board of directors and treasurer of the Atlanta Regional Commission.

He was inaugurated as the Georgia Municipal Association's 83rd president in June 2015, completing his term as of June 2016. Prior to his ascension as president, he previously served as the organization's First Vice President and past chair of the Revenue and Finance Committee, Federal Policy Council, and Legislative Policy Council. He was inducted in the Georgia Municipal Hall of Fame as a result of his tenure as President of GMA.

Mayor Bodker also serves in leadership of the U.S. Conference of Mayors as Vice Chair of the Tourism, Arts, Parks, and Entertainment & Sports Standing Committee, and on the boards of the Greater North Fulton Chamber of Commerce, the Johns Creek Chamber of Commerce and the North Fulton Municipal Association.

Bodker has twin children, Jake and Keri (12), and is married to wife Lisa, who recently gave birth to their daughter, Emma Kate.
